## AEgis announces substantial price reductions for acsIX tools

AEgis recently announced substantial price reductions for the acsIX family of tools for modeling and simulation, which are widely used for PBPK and PK/PD modeling. The full version, which includes textual and graphical languages for specifying complex kinetics/dynamics models, and a Matlab-like scripting language for specification of parameter estimation, sensitivity analysis, Monte-Carlo, or Markov-Chain Monte Carlo analyses, is now priced starting at \$500 US. The price reduction is intended to make acsIX accessible to a wider community of modelers seeking an affordable high-end commercial simulation tool, and to increase the audience of potential end-users of models developed by current acsIX customers. The latest version of acsIX includes support for cluster/grid computing, and provides data integration capabilities with Microsoft Excel and Access. A PBPK/PK/PD toolkit is also available, and a Bayesian population modeling capability based on MCMC analysis is planned for early this year.
